

Feed Market Remains Firm On West Coast

Feed markets at Portland and other West Coast terminals continued to display a firm tone during the week ended August 8, according to reports to the War Food Administration.

High protein feeds also remained unchanged for the period with prices at ceilings on those items for which maximums have been established.

Consumption of ground grain for feed increased materially during the past season due to heavier feeding and large number of livestock.

Ground oats are richer in food value but are also more expensive than milfeeds.
