# By Quinn Hall Grain Futures Finish Strong

CHICAGO, Sept. 7 - (P) - Grain futures markets fluctuated erratically today, rallying shortly after the opening only to break ta mid-session, then advance at the close.

Rye hit new season lows before noon and at the bottom sold at 93%, more than 40 cents below the high established for that contract last January.

Wheat turned strong shortly before the close and prices moved to new highs for the session. Short covering was induced by contin-ued strength of wheat at Minneapolis and additional purchases of cash grain by the commodity credit corporation.

At the close wheat was 1% to 2% higher than yesterday's close, September \$1.54%. Oats were % lower to 1% higher, September 59%-%. Rye was % (CQ) lower

to % higher, barley was off % to 1, September \$1.04%. Some of the late strength in wheat was attributed to mill buying. CCC purchases in the northwest at \$1.52 a bushel for No. 1 northern spring were reported.
