

### Shock Fatal To Mrs. Mayes

**Woodburn Woman Dies Following Husband's Accidental Death**

WOODBURN, Sept. 16—Mrs. Sarah Ellen Mayes, 68, died at 3:30 Saturday afternoon, 24 hours after her husband, Perry Wright Mayes, was killed in a railroad crossing accident. Mrs. Mayes suffered from shock when notified of her husband's death and suffered a heart attack at 3 p.m. at the Woodburn hospital.

Double funeral services will be held Monday at 2 p.m. from the Ringo chapel. Rev. Frank Martin of the Four Square Gospel church will officiate and burial will be made in the Aurora cemetery.

Mrs. Mayes was born May 30, 1876, at Morgantown, W. Va., and her husband, Perry Wright Mayes was born September of the same year. Survivors are the son, Richard Mayes, now believed to be in a hospital in the South Pacific; three daughters, Mrs. Jean Price, Bremerton; Mrs. Mary Kidner, Portland; Mrs. Helen Yergen, Aurora, also four grandchildren. Mr. and Mrs. Mayes had lived in Woodburn for 15 years and had been in Oregon for 48 years.

### Wigrich Hop Yard Has Health Staff

MONMOUTH—Mrs. Naomi Fresh is employed as a registered nurse at the Wigrich hop yard where about 300 Mexican men are employed in the hop harvest. These men are secured through federal employment measures, and are given every attention to protect and preserve their health while so employed. Blood tests and all the minute of detailed medical procedure is part of the employment program. Dr. C. A. Fratzke of Independence is the physician in charge. The men had a siege of mumps but are now recuperated.

A specialized hop picking detail is said to be in progress at Wigrich, where hops are picked and cured for medical purposes. They are picked without a stem or leaf—just hops, only—and a special price for picking, above the average rate, is paid the workers.
