

Hop Markets Remain Firm During Week

PORTLAND, Sept. 29.—(P)—The week ending Sept. 27 saw Pacific coast hop markets remaining firm, with prices tightly wedged at the OPA ceilings, the war food administration said today.

In Oregon, harvesting of the 1944 hop crop was almost completed and baling was well along. A labor shortage was reported by some custom balers. No new developments took place at hop markets.

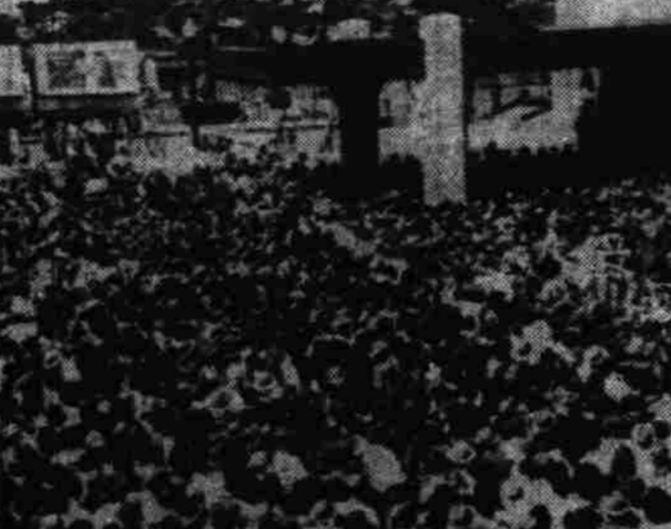
