Frankfurters with Hot potato salad
Tray of raw vegetables
Hot biscuits and honey
Gingerbread squares with Bananas filling
Coffee or cocoa
The potato salad and the dessert can be made ahead of time.

the frankfurters may be added the last minute before serving. **FRANKFURTERS WITH HOT POTATO SALAD**
1 pound frankfurters
6 medium-sized potatoes
1 onion, minced

Hot Dressing:
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper
1 teaspoon dry mustard
4 tablespoons sugar
1/2 cup water
1/2 cup vinegar
1 egg, slightly beaten
4 slices bacon, diced

Cook potatoes in skins and remove skins while hot. Cut in 1/2-inch cubes. Mince onion and add to potatoes. Cover frankfurters with hot water, and heat slowly but do not boil.

To make dressing: combine dry ingredients. Add liquids and beaten egg. Cook diced bacon until light brown, and combine with other mixture, cook only until egg thickens. Pour over potato cubes mixed with onion, and heat salad until liquid is absorbed. Arrange on hot platter with heated frankfurters. Serves 6.

COFFEE BOSTON CREAM PIE
1/4 cup sugar
1/4 cup flour
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/4 cup cold coffee
1/4 cup scalded milk
1 egg yolk
1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
6 squares cake
Powdered sugar

Mix sugar, flour, and salt in top of small double boiler. Stir in cold coffee gradually, and when smooth, add scalded milk. Stir over hot water until mixture thickens. Cover and cook 8 minutes. Stir some of the hot custard mixture into slightly beaten egg yolk and stir this into remaining hot mixture. Stir 2 minutes over hot water and add vanilla extract. Four custard into bowl, cover and cool thoroughly. Slice squares of cake into halves, and place custard between halves. Sprinkle top with powdered sugar. Yield: 6 servings.
