The week of November 5 to 11 has been designated this year for the 24th annual observance of American Education week, the general theme of which is to be "Education for New Tasks".

American Education week provides school people with an excellent opportunity for a concerted, nationwide effort to improve public understanding of the work of the schools. As a contribution this year to Education Week, I shall attempt to review the effort that schools are making in supplying food needs for school children.

Need on Increase

Salem schools are faced with an ever-increasing number of children who do not go home for the noon meal or are in need of supplemental feeding. We have an increased number of boys and girls who come in from outlying areas in buses and a great number must stay because both parents are in industry.

The schools interest in the school lunch centers around the relationship between eating and

the child's health and growth, and the ways in which the school lunch can be used in the health instruction program.

Genuine Concern

Schools of today have a genuine concern for children's physical growth; for the relation which normal physical growth has to mental hygiene, personality development, educational progress. Schools show an extensive interest in meals children eat during the school day and to the education of children and parents regarding modern nutrition.

said to have been accepted generally as an important phase of the school health and educational program.

Salem schools already have come to the front in developing the school lunch and the lunchroom as a true laboratory in which the theoretical and the practical can be brought together. Mealtime is a good time to teach food selection, nutrition, table manners, practices of personal hygiene, food preparation, refrigeration, milk pasteurization, fly control and cleanliness of food handlers.

Rooms Attractive

The dining rooms thus far established are being made more attractive through the use of inexpensive decorations such as plants and pictures. Health posters, exhibits and other materials help to make the dining room more pleasant. Pupils help in keeping the cafeteria and dining room in order during the mealtime and assist with the serving of the meal.

The lunchroom thus becomes the natural laboratory for much of the program of health instruction at the same time that it makes a major contribution to children's normal physical growth and maintenance of health.

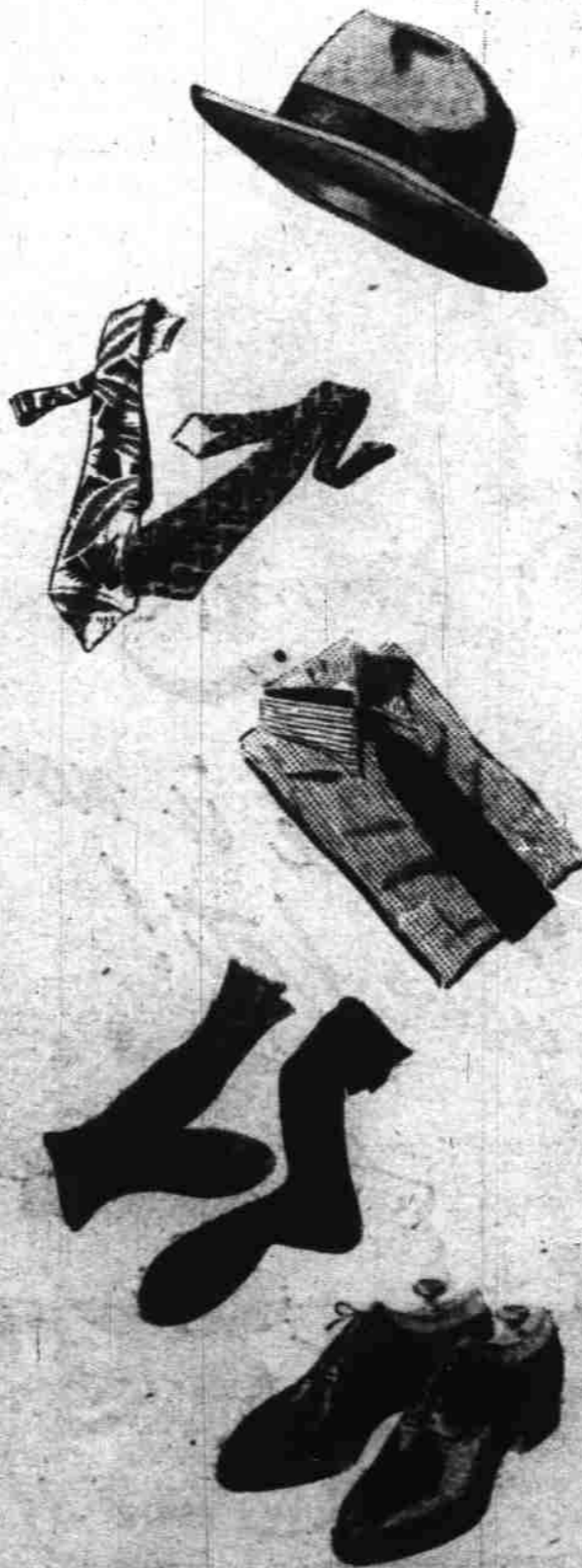
