Signaling the launching of an intensive statewide recruiting program designed to boost the Oregon district to the top of the navy's priority enlistment branch—radar—the Salem navy recruiting office today at Salem high school with full day of screening examinations scheduled for several score 17-year-olds, deemed tentatively eligible for radio technician training.

Grains Have Jitters But Close Strong

CHICAGO, March 27.—(AP)—Grain markets had peace jitters today, starting firm and then undergoing a sharp dip on unconfirmed rumors of an armistice. Wheat and rye broke a cent or more from the early top, but short covering gave the market a firmer tone and most of the losses were recovered at the close.

Corn was steady at the start, on commission house selling but broke with other grains. At the close wheat was 1/4 to 1/2 higher than yesterday's close, May \$1.68 1/4. Corn was 1/4 to 1/2 lower, May \$1.10 1/4. Oats were 1/4 to 1/2 higher, May 63 1/2. Rye was unchanged to 1/4 higher, May \$1.18 1/4. Barley was 1/4 to 1/2 lower, May \$1.07 1/2.

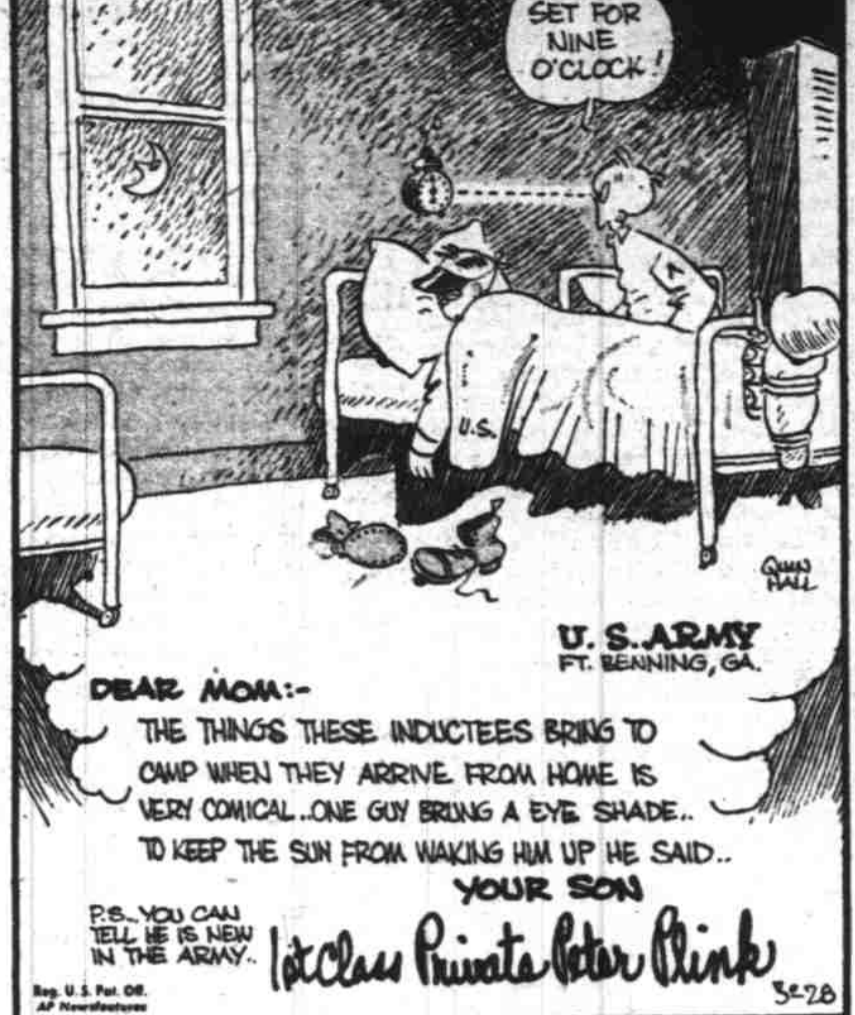
