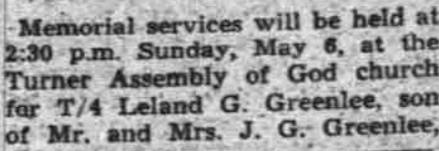

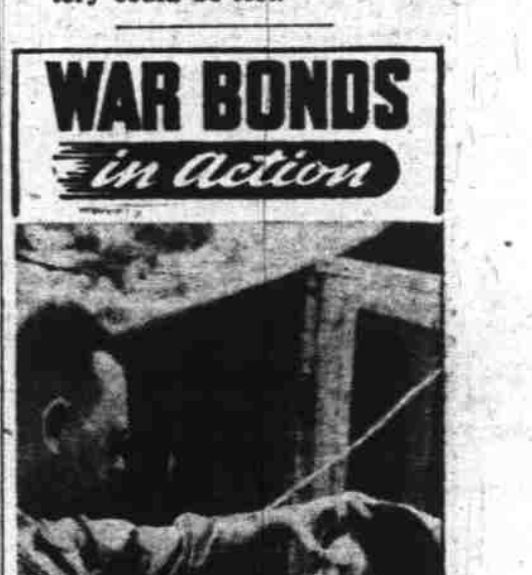
Concert Will Be Given on Sunday Night
