

Stocks End Bad Week Gaining

NEW YORK, June 30 (AP)—The stock market today finished its worst week of the past three months with aviation, utilities and selected industrials pacing a general recovery.

While numerous pivots failed to achieve more than small comebacks, advances of fractions to two or more points were well in the majority at the close. Transfers for the two hours totaled 660,000 shares compared with 960,000 last Saturday.

Accounts were reinstated in most cases on the idea recent liquidation had been overdone, that post-war prospects still were bright and idle funds would continue to seek profitable investment.

The Associated Press 60-stock average was up .3 of a point at 66.3 but for the week was off 1.4 points, widest dip since the period ended March 24. For the month the composite was ahead 3 of a point.

All Grains Up, Rye Soars 3 1/2

CHICAGO, June 30 (AP)—Rye soared as much as 3 1/2 cents a bushel and other grain markets finished strong today with practically the entire futures list showing gains of more than a penny.

Prices had been sharply higher from the start and shortly before the close, after hedging and profit cashing had run their course, offerings dried up. Many final quotations were near the day's best support.

Best support came from cash interests—flour millers, feed mixers and distillers—and most of the selling was on resting orders. Short covering was evident from the start and stop-loss buying, particularly in rye, developed just before the finish.

Millers bought wheat persistently. At the finish wheat was 3/4 to 1 1/2 higher than yesterday's close, July \$1.67 3/4. Corn was unchanged to up 1/4, July \$1.18 1/2. Oats were 1/4 to 1 1/2 higher, July 68 1/2-68.
