Many Disputes Settled by Conciliation

The conciliation service, U.S. department of labor, received 1,757 requests to mediate labor disputes in the 11 western states, Alaska and Hawaii, during the first six months of 1945, and settled 1440 of them, or 81 per cent, it was announced Saturday in San Francisco by E. P. Marsh, regional director of the service.
