Grains Stage Recovery But Closing Weak

CHICAGO, July 19-(AP)-Most grain futures staged a partial recovery today although late selling cut down the advances.

Such bullish factors as extension of the whisky holiday into August, trade belief that distillers would have to use more wheat and rye, and continued feed grains scarčity led to early buying which pushed rye prices up as much as 21/2 cents a bushel and wheat a cent. The trade also noted official state department denial of Japanese peace rumors. Selling, including hedging op-

erations, developed later. Wheat closed 1/8 lower to 1/2 higher than the previous finish, July \$1.6332-58; corn was unchanged to 1% cent higher, July \$1.511/8, and barley was 1/2 lower to 1 cent higher, July \$1.161/4.
