> **Motors Lead** Declines on Stock Market

NEW YORK, Nov. 19-(AP)-Motors, depressed by the new OPA automobile ceilings and an imminent strike threat, led a general decline in today's stock market although early casualties of three or more points were reduced at the close and assorted favorites finished with comfortable ad-

Late openers were General Motors and Chrysler, the former off a point on a 1200-share block and the latter down two on 600 shares. They extended their retreat, recovered after midday, slipped again and ended off 34 and 1%, respectively. Transfers totalled 2,020,000 shares compared with

2,340,000 Friday. Coppers improved as domestic demand increased with shortages and revived talk of the government resuming foreign purchase of the metal. Scattered issues were spurred by dividends and earnings prospects. Idle cash and inflation thinking persisted as bullish factors. The fact the list had touched a peak since 1931, however, inspired profit cashing on the theory a good-sized technical correction could eventuate.
