MT. ANGEL, April 20—(Special)—Mrs. Josephine Melchior, a native of Wisconsin and a local resident for the last six years, died at the age of 86 Friday night in a Portland hospital. Widow of the late Mike Melchior, she had come to Portland with him in 1893 and subsequently lived 40 years in Tillamook.

Last rites will be conducted at St. Mary's church at 10 a.m. Tuesday. Burial will be in Calvary cemetery, with Unger funeral home in charge.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Veronica Nitch of Portland; three sons, the Rev. Hildebrand Melchior, Woodburn; Mike Melchior, Salem, and Hubert Melchior, Los Angeles, Calif.; two sisters, Mrs. Lena Kraut and Mrs. Kate Gephart, both of Lakeville, Minn.

Woodburn Pool Plans Delayed

WOODBURN, April 20—(Special)—Plans for construction of the swimming pool will go ahead this year even though construction will not be ready for use this season. This was the decision of the city council Tuesday night.

Bids will be received as soon as a site has been selected. Architect L. P. Bartholomew of Salem said it would take four months for construction. It is considered undesirable to select the site at the primary election.

In response to petition of property owners, the council instructed the city engineer to draw up plans and specifications for paving of Oak, South First, Gath and Brown streets.

Mayor H. P. Austin announced the budget committee would be appointed May 7 and will meet May 15.

Gary Cooper, Ingrid Bergman In Elsinore's 'Saratoga Trunk'

Starting two of Hollywood's most colorful figures, Gary Cooper and Ingrid Bergman, Warner Brothers' lustiest of dramas, "Saratoga Trunk" is now playing at the Elsinore theater. Linn County's Relief Mounts

ALBANY, April 20—(Special)—During the month of March, according to the report of Mrs. Ruth Cotter, Linn county public health administrator, 1,160 persons in Linn county received aid through the commission, and \$31,312.53 was distributed. The report showed that this amount was an increase of \$628.39 over February relief.

During March a total of \$6197.53 was paid to 341 persons, comprising 164 cases in general assistance, \$1421.05 being for medical care hospitalization. Old age assistance totaled \$19,918 and was distributed among 570 persons over 65 years of age, who were in want; and \$4524 to 58 families, including 175 children in the form of aid to dependent children.

The 16 blind persons in the county received a total of \$673. Average grant person was general assistance \$37.79; old age assistance \$34.98; dependent children \$78; and blind \$42.06.
