Navy Recruit Staff Adds Vet

Chief Commissary Steward Verlin M. Coontz, who saw action in the Aleutians, Guadalcanal, in the Gilberts, Marshalls and Philippines and at Okinawa with task force No. 58, has reported for recruiting duty at the Salem U. S. navy recruiting substation. Chief Quartermaster R. B. Fallon announced the addition to his staff Monday. Coontz, who joined the Portland navy recruiting station from Dallas, Tex., enlisted in San Francisco in 1937. Following his recruit training, he served on the USS Lexington until 1939, then aboard the Henderson, Morris and Melville, and in September, 1941, transferred aboard the USS McLeish, operating off the English coast during the blitzes. He was returned to the United States in 1942 and on the USS Meade served with the Pacific fleet.

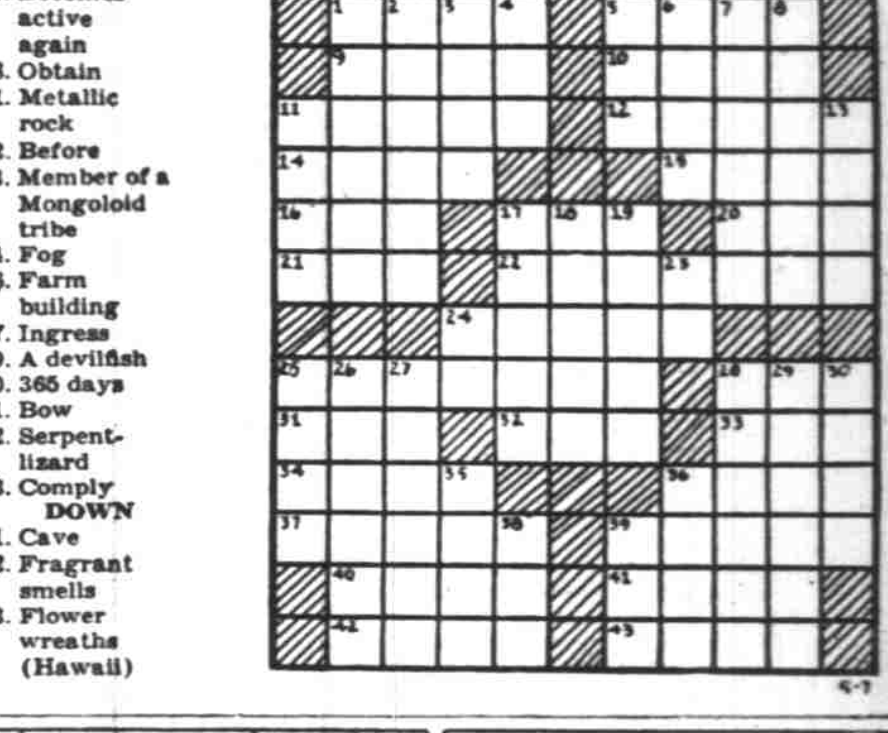
