### Sewer Dumping Investigation Is Requested

SILVERTON, May 7 (Special)—The new Isaak Walton league auxiliary Monday night submitted a letter to the city council requesting that sewers dumping directly into Silver creek be investigated. The matter was left to City Manager Robert Borland to investigate, as was also rearranging the parking at Silverton, policing public dances and oiling of streets in the neighborhood of the Kolstad Cannery, Inc. plant.

As the Home Guard is renting the armory to the dance orchestra about which complaints are made, suggestion it police the dance.

Victor Grossnickle, night officer, requested to receive no fees from business men for "rattling doors" and turning out lights, reported this would reduce his salary to \$160 a month. 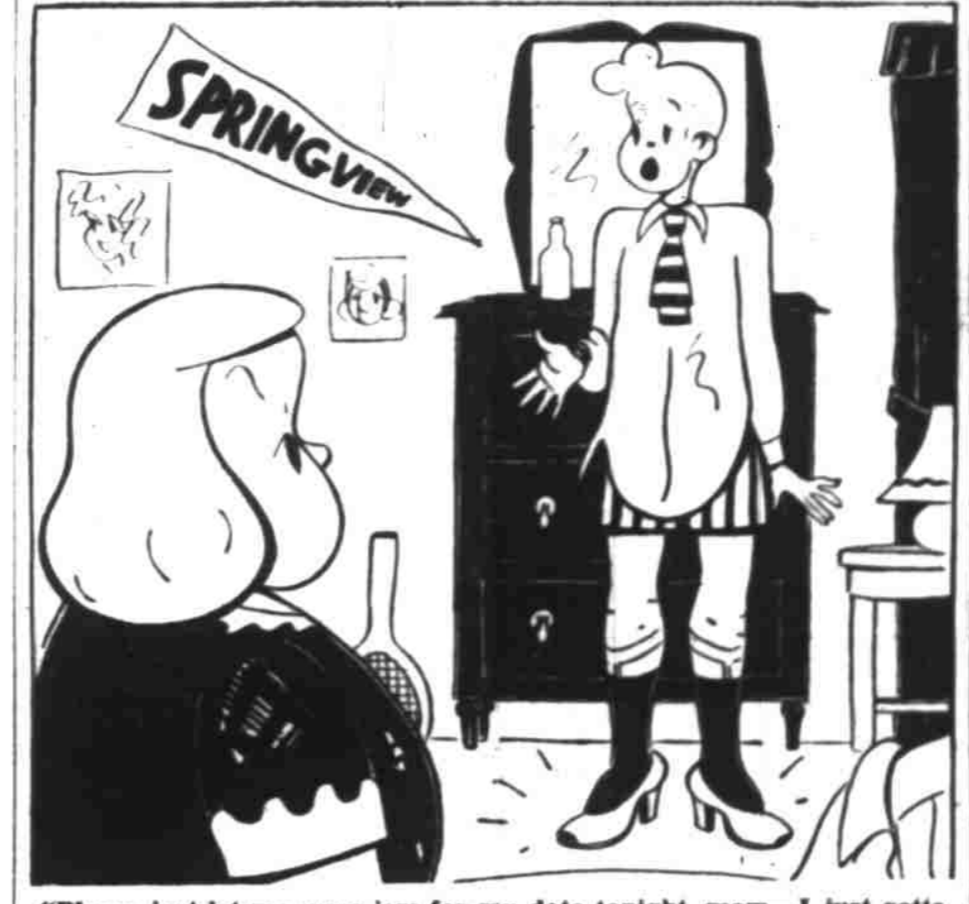

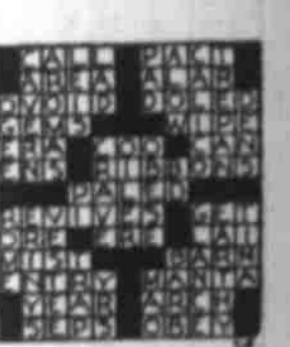
