NEW YORK, June 6-(AP)-Buy-ing of selected rails, industrials and utilities steadied the stock market today although many leaders were neglected in lower

territory. Carriers came to the fore after midday, with bidding here attributed to the belief this group had been oversold. A number of increased and extra dividends failed to spur most issues concerned. Numerous customers continued to hold aloof because of the labor situation, including the walkout of 62,000 AFL seamen. Bids were reinstated here and there on the theory that four successive declining sessions had acted as a partial corrective of the lengthy climb to 15-year peaks.

Dealings were slack from the start. Forenoon losses of fractions to 2 or more points were reduced or converted into plus signs after midday without any pickup in activity. Closing trends were no worse than moderately irregular. Transfers of 980,000 shares compared with 1,170,000 Wednesday and were the smallest since May 20. The Associated Press 60-stock composite was unchanged at 81.
