

### Five Trophies To Be Offered At Rose Show

Exhibitors at Salem's Rose show to be held at the YMCA June 15-16 will have a chance to win one or more of five trophies obtained by the show committee of the Salem Rose society, sponsor of the annual event.

The grand sweepstakes trophy which will go to the exhibitor of the best rose consists of a large globe mounted on a cylindrical base and surmounted by a figure of winged victory. Measuring 30 inches in height, it is offered by the officers of the Salem Rose society.

To the exhibitor of the best rose in Division I (horticultural), the Salem Men's Garden club is offering a gold cup.

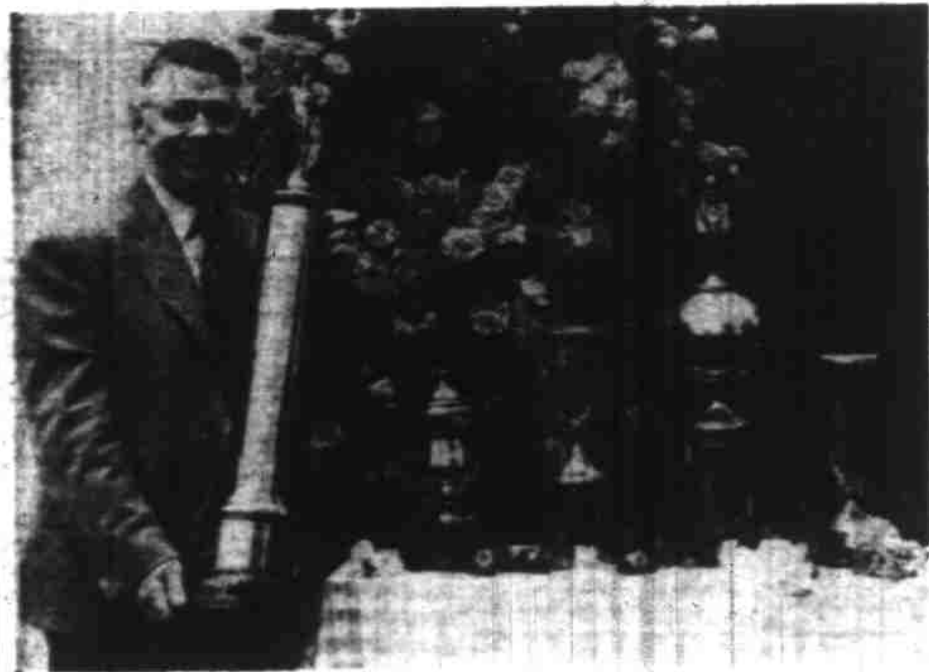
Another gold cup 14 inches tall will go to the exhibitor of the best rose in the junior division. It is provided by the Salem Kiwanis club.

A gold trophy consisting of a cylindrical pedestal surmounted by a figure of Liberty bearing a torch, standing 36 inches high, is offered by the Rose society to the garden club of Marion or Polk county with the best exhibit. The exhibit must contain at least ten varieties of roses.

A gold cup is offered by Stevens & Son of Salem to the exhibitor of the best floral arrangement.

All of these are revolving trophies, to be held by the winner for one year. Name of the winner is to be engraved each year.

There also will be valuable prizes and ribbons for the best exhibits in each division, according to Ray Warren, chairman of the show committee.

### Nut Growers Attend Meet, Elect Officers

Four hundred and fifty nut growers attended the annual meeting of the Dundee Nut Growers association at Dundee May 28, the next to the largest gathering in the organization's history.

Talks were made by Roy Miller on pest control; D. E. Wilson, director of the association, on polonization, and by Robert Gerald, assistant manager of the North Pacific Nut Growers, on the world nut situation. C. E. Schuster, horticulturist; Paul W. Miller, plant pathologist, and B. G. Thompson, associate entomologist of the department of agriculture and Oregon State college talked on cultural and nut disease problems.

The Dundee Nut Growers did over a million and a half dollars of business in 1945.

### Ivan Stewart Elected Rotary District Chief

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J., June 6—Ivan Stewart, 883 N. Cottage st., operator of a warehousing and farming business in Salem, and a past president of the Rotary club of Salem, was today unanimously elected district governor of Rotary International at Rotary's 37th annual convention which is being held here this week. He will succeed George W. Peavy of Corvallis.

Elected by delegates represent-

ing Rotary's 5800 clubs and 271,000 members in 72 countries, Mr. Stewart will assume his duties as district governor on July 1. As an officer of Rotary International he will visit the 33 clubs which comprise the 102nd district, one of three Rotary districts in Oregon and Washington. He will assist the officers of these clubs pertaining to Rotary service activities and administration.

This district carried Stewart's unanimous nomination to the convention.
