BELGRADE, June 12—(AP)—Gen. Draja Mihailovic testified today that a British mission to Yugoslavia instructed him to destroy Marshal Tito's partisans, and described his relations with the Germans in 1943 as "no cooperation, but haphazard mutual battle" against Tito's forces.
