# Midshipman Krug Inspects Installations At Bonneville



PORTLAND, Ore., June 13—(AP)—Secretary of the Interior J. A. Krug told a press conference today he hoped the Bonneville administration would find "effective means" to utilize vast Columbia river power resources in peacetime economy.

As director of the war production board, he said, he saw the electrical development for which electrical power was responsible in this area. "Eminent progress has been made in retaining and increasing it," he said. Here on a western tour, he inspected Bonneville dam and the world's largest electrical sub-station, near Vancouver, Wash.

"Electrical power is the life blood of the economy of the country—particularly low cost power as you have here in the west," Krug declared.

He said he hoped to "greatly improve" the integration of the loosely coordinated interior department.

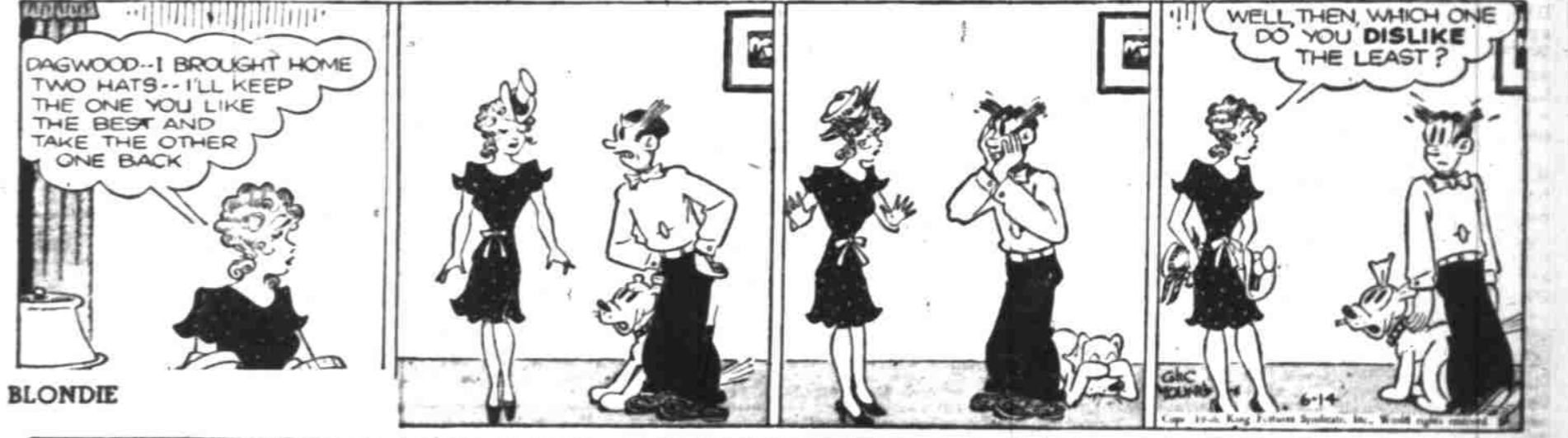
