

Oats Contracts Change Little

CHICAGO, June 13—(AP)—Oats contracts finished with little change today after advancing to their maximums at one time and then dropping below their preceding close when directors of the board stopped trading in all wheat and rye and July and September corn and barley.

Final prices were unchanged to 1/4 higher than the preceding close, August 87 1/2. There were sales in July and September wheat and corn at ceilings before trading in these grains was halted.

Stopping of trading in other grains, and ordering settlement at present ceilings, brought about moderate sales of oats by traders who had bought oats as a protection for their "short" position in other grain. However, this selling dried up quickly after the cereal dropped a little less than a cent from its high.
