Robert Shaw takes the baton in the NBC summer symphony concert this afternoon at 1 o'clock.

The Herbert Merrill show at 10 a. m. (NBC) today will include favorites as "Danny Deane," "Sylvia" and "Flone Alone," with Merrill singing and Frank Bak's orchestra playing.

At 10:30 listeners may hear the Earl Murray double quartet in a number of South barbershop favorites as "By the Light of the Silvery Moon," "Sweetheart of Sigma Chi" and "When You Wore a T.," they also sang a medley of songs of the 90's. The orchestra includes several Victor Herbert numbers and the "March of the Squire" from "Caucasian Sketches."

The Columbia Symphony orchestra plays on KOIN from 11 a. m. to noon.

At 11 the NBC symphony under Robert Shaw will play Beethoven's symphony No. 2 in D (four movements), Schumann's "Sym-

phony for Strings" and a "Folk Overture" by Mennin.

Festival of American Music is slated for 4 o'clock on ABC and the Standard symphony for 7:30.

Igor Gorin is named as the Firestone soloist on Monday night at 4:30 and Josef Hoffman will play with the Bell Symphonic orchestra at 5 p. m. Both are on NBC.

- At Salem: Nine team mowers, 6 asphalt kettles, 1 lot of 8 gasoline pumps, scrap metals, radiator cores, batteries, tires and tubes.
- At Coquille: Scrap metals, radiator cores, batteries, tires and 1-18 ft. boat.
- At Klamath Falls: Three patrol graders, 1 team mower, 1 gasoline engine, 1 asphalt kettle, scrap metals, batteries and tires.
- At LaGrande: One patrol grader, scrap metals, radiator cores, batteries, tires, tubes and scrap paper.

Separate proposal forms have been prepared for the used equipment stored at Salem, and at Klamath Falls, and for the scrap materials stored at each one of the four places mentioned above. The bidder should specify which ones are desired when requesting the proposal forms.
