"Crab meat Bordelaise" is yet another. Small bits of bacon, ham and smoked tongue are added to crab meat. Simmer a moment then put in open casserole with cream of tomato soup, adding a little Bordelaise sauce (butter, crab. onion, carrot, parsley, seasonings and brown stock) and decorate with crab claws and parsley.




