Handicapped Men Proving Fine Employees

TAMPA, Fla.—When E. P. Pinaire opened a small furniture factory here, he decided to give work so far as he was able to physically-handicapped men. Now, he says, it's worked out fine.
 Pinaire, former shipyard personnel director here, has five veterans and two non-veterans with physical handicaps on his staff of 15 men. He says they do good work because he has relied on matching the job to the man.
 "For instance," he said, "my

shop foreman was wounded in the back at Kwajalein. He finds it uncomfortable to sit down for long periods of time, but standing up on a job doesn't bother him at all."

Two of his employes have maimed hands, one from birth and the other from wounds received on Iwo Jima. At work on shaping machines which require minimum use of hand or arm, both are valuable workers.
 "The handicapped worker," Pinaire said, "makes as good if not better employe than the average able-bodied individual because the man with some physical disability is more careful, less prone to have an accident, and has a much lower absenteeism rate."
