Pre-Christmas Days Are for Baking, Candy Making: Recipes Are Selected

Ginger cookies, traditionally, are for Christmas, and fortunately are made with molasses. This recipe for the cookie which children, especially, like, uses very little sugar and a grain or two might be subtracted from the recipe, in case your sugar supply is really low.

Here's a recipe which came from the molasses people, and when I tried it out claimed all but my last 1/4 cup of sugar.

GINGERBREAD MEN
3 cups flour
1 1/2 teaspoons salt
1 teaspoon soda
1/2 teaspoon baking powder
2 teaspoons ginger
1 teaspoon cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon nutmeg
1/2 cup shortening
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 cup molasses
1 egg, beaten
Cream sugar and shortening, gradually blend in molasses, then egg, then add dry ingredients. Chill for awhile and roll out and cut. Bake 8 to 10 minutes in moderate oven (375) on lightly greased tins.
These can also be used for icebox type cookies.

Candied orange and grapefruit peel is an ever popular sweet for holiday time. Here is a recipe which produces a more moist peel than some.

CANDIED ORANGE PEEL
Cut peel in pieces convenient for handling and cover with twice its quantity of cold water. Bring to a boil and cook until tender enough to pierce with fingernail. Drain, measure peel, packing it lightly in the cup. Add an equal quantity of sugar (no water except what clings to peel). Boil until a thick syrup is formed. Stir to make sure all peel is covered with syrup. Let stand overnight. Next day boil until syrup is thick enough to harden when cold, stir gently from time to time while cooking. Lift out pieces of peel and let drain on paper.
