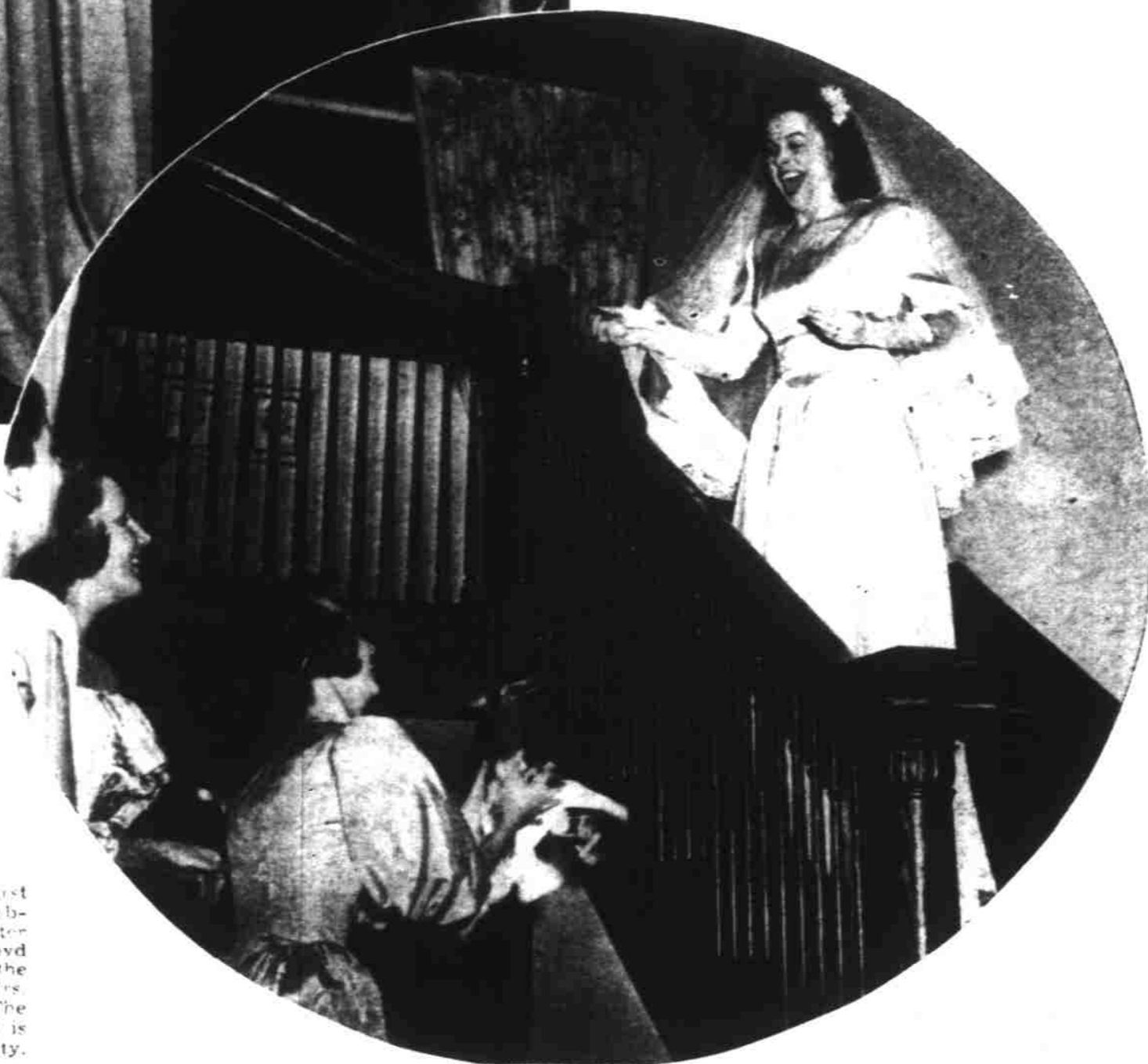
Oregon State Mothers Tea . . .
