WEST SALEM, July 1 — The 1947-48 budget election vote was canvassed at a special meeting of West Salem city council here tonight. The canvass showed the budget was approved 37 to 10. No other business was transacted.

### Negro Maid Testifies at Slavery Trial

SAN DIEGO, Calif., July 1 — (AP) — First testimony that negro maid Dora Jones served Mr. and Mrs. Howard Wesley Ingalls for years without pay was given at the federal court slavery trial of the New England couple here today.

The Ingalls' son-in-law, Richard Roberts, Berkeley, Calif., chemist and former Cornell university instructor, and a Berkeley police sergeant also testified that the negro was threatened with jail or commitment to an institution by the Ingalls if she left them.

Roberts denied under cross-examination that he was a communist or that he and his father-in-law had been "enemies" from the time of his marriage to Helen Ingalls in 1941. He said that Dora Jones declared last Oct. 11, during a conference at the Berkeley police station that she had never asked the Ingalls for pay — "because she knew she wouldn't get it."

Mrs. Ingalls told him, the police officer said, that she and her husband, former Lynn and Boston, Mass., lawyer, had kept Dora in their service without pay because she was originally a "protege" of Mrs. Ingalls.

Faculty appointments in the sociology and romance departments of Willamette university were announced Tuesday by President G. Herbert Smith, both professors to begin their work here in September.

Dr. John A. Rademaker, who has been vice president of the Hawaiian Association of Civic Unity and a University of Hawaii professor, will become head of the sociology department at Willamette. He is a College of Puget Sound graduate who received master's and doctor's degrees at University of Washington.

Dr. George D. Hocking will come from Stephens college, Mo., to teach Spanish and French. He is a graduate of University of Wisconsin who later earned a doctorate at Johns Hopkins university. During the war he was a cultural relations advisor for the U. S. state department, stationed in Buenos Aires.
