### Recluse Said Draft Evader

HOOD RIVER, Ore., Aug. 2.—(AP)—A heavily bearded man with shoulder-length hair was in the county jail here tonight after what FBI said was a five-year hideout from military service.

Sheriff Rupert L. Gilmore identified the man as Stridan Grant Delepine, 48, Hood River, and FBI agents said he last was seen walking away from a bus that was to take draftees to an induction center in August, 1942.

The sheriff said Delepine was arrested on the city outskirts in a small cabin, which he had left rarely in the last five years. Neighbors said they had never seen him.

### Tito, Dimitrov Complete Pact

BELGRADE, Aug. 2.—(AP)—Marshal Tito and Bulgarian Premier Georgi Dimitrov, winding up three days of conferences, concluded today a political, economic and social agreement under which Yugoslavia and Bulgaria will aid one another and work toward a full customs union.

### Two Medals Ready For Navy Vets at Program Tuesday

Eligible navy veterans may obtain their American defense service medals and World War II victory medals Tuesday night at 8 o'clock at the VFW hall, Cottage and Hood streets, officials announced Saturday. The ceremony here will be the first such presentation in Oregon.

VFW members Saturday night made plans in cooperation with the navy department. To be eligible for the defense medal, the navy veteran must have served on active duty between Sept. 8, 1939, and Dec. 7, 1941, inclusive, and for the victory medal must have served on active duty at any time between Dec. 7, 1941, and Dec. 31, 1946. Ex-Waves are also eligible under these conditions.

Applicants will be asked to fill out two blanks and must display their original discharge certificates. Master of ceremonies for the presentations, under direction of Salem Beaver Navy post 7775, VFW, will be Carl Cover, and Irvin Bryan, past post commander, will be principal speaker. On hand to help in distribution will be members of all of Salem's VFW posts and CGM P. A. Raney and his crew from the Salem naval recruiting station.
