**U.S. Shipley Dies; Funeral This Afternoon**

Ulysses G. Shipley, 81, of 945 Parrish st., Salem business man for more than 35 years, died Wednesday night at a local hospital of a cerebral hemorrhage that followed an illness of two days. He was born in Rochester, N. Y. and received his early merchandising experience with a store in Byron, N. Y., later being associated with Sidley, Linsey and Kerr in Rochester. When he first came to Oregon on vacation in 1892, he was impressed with the state and remained here to take a position with Olds, Wortman and King department store in Portland.

He remained with the Portland firm until coming to Salem to open his own business in 1911 at the present location of Bishop's Clothing store. The business was later moved to the present Schlesinger company store, where he was in business until 1937. Since then he has been associated with Schlesinger's.

He attended the St. Paul's Episcopal church and was a member of the Masons and the Elks lodge. Survivors are the widow, Mattie, to whom he was married on Christmas day, 1895; a brother, F. O. Shipley, Pownell, Maine; and two nieces, Mrs. Ada Coleman and Mrs. Frank Bloomfield, Rochester, N. Y. Four children born to the couple all died in infancy.

Funeral services will be held today at 4:30 p. m. at St. Paul's Episcopal church, with the Rev. George H. Swift officiating. A request has been made by the family to omit flowers for the services, which are directed by the Clough-Barrick company.

**AFL Teamster Boss Refuses Pay Increase**

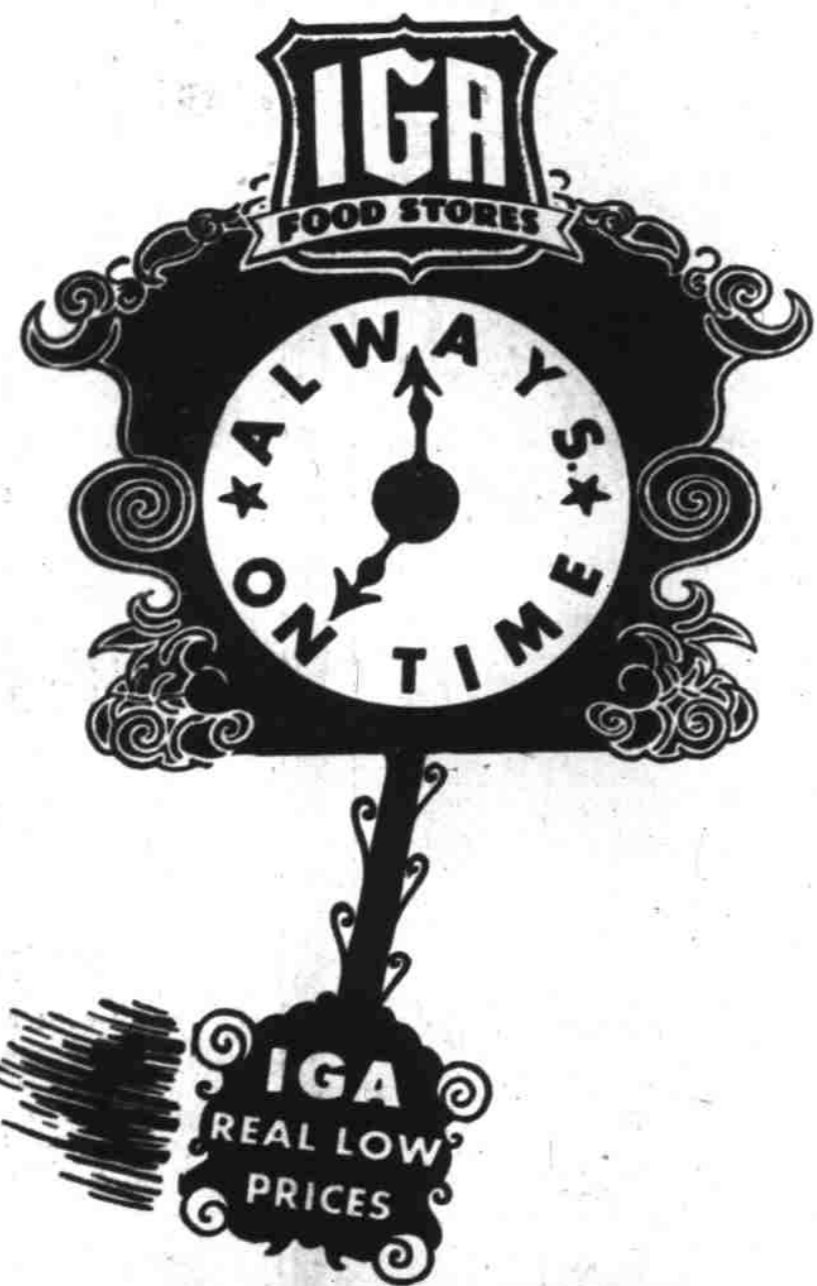
**SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 14**—(AP) Daniel J. Tobin, president of the AFL teamsters, told delegates to the union's international convention Wednesday he would resign if the convention increased his present \$30,000 yearly salary. "I will resign if you pay me more money," the 71-year-old teamster chief told delegates in response to a move to give him a pay raise.

"I would like to resign now," he added, "but we have been strangled by the Taft-Hartley act and I feel it my duty to stay on and fight to show the people that labor is decent and clean—and a little unselfish."

Coupled with Tobin's salary was an effort by J. F. English of Boston, international secretary-treasurer, to have his own salary reduced from \$30,000 to \$20,000. Delegates shouted him down on grounds it was a bad precedent for future wage bargaining with employers.

Tobin supported the move to reduce English's salary, declaring an officer in a subordinate post should receive a lesser salary than the president. Both proposals to increase Tobin's \$30,000-a-year salary and cut the pay of the international secretary-treasurer were voted down by the delegates.
