Dallas School Reopening Set For September 22

DALLAS — Schools will open Monday, September 22. Registration of high school students will begin Tuesday, September 16.

Principal Joseph W. Smith, Superintendent S. E. Whitworth and other members of the staff will be in the high school building Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 9 to 12 and from 1 to 4. The building also will be open on Thursday evening, September 18, from 7 to 9, to accommodate those unable to register on regular registration days.

It is asked that the following schedule be adhered to as far as possible: Seniors, Tuesday, September 16; juniors, Wednesday, September 17; sophomores, Thursday, September 18; freshmen, Friday, September 19.

The fee for towel service in the physical education classes will be \$2.50 for the year. The student body fee will be \$3.50. These fees will be collected at the time of registration.

It will not be necessary for pupils of the elementary and junior high buildings to register until the first day of school. The first to fourth grades will attend the elementary building, with grades five to eight inclusive at the junior high building.
