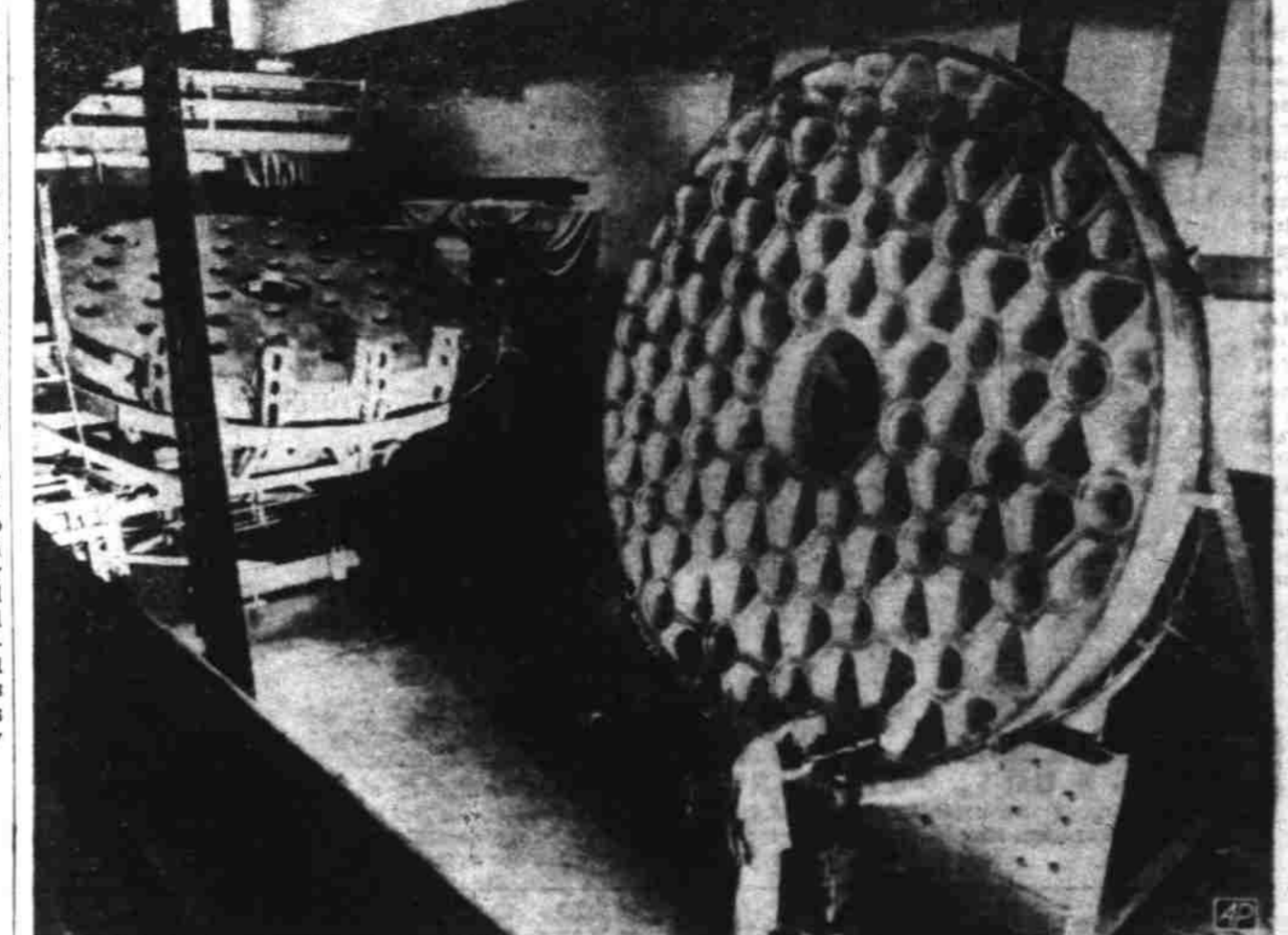
Non-Partisan Work Agreed in Drive For NW Power

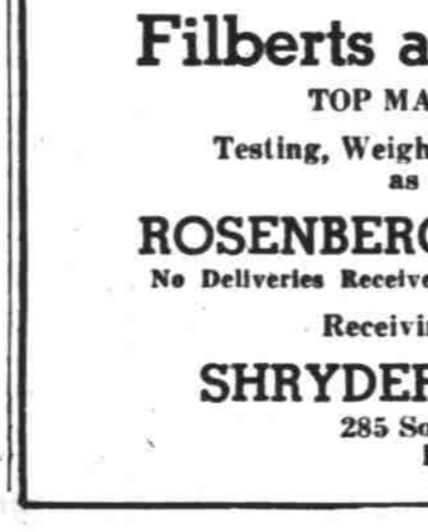
19-Year-Old Owns U.S. Champ Steer
