Salem Heights water district became consolidated with four surrounding districts in elections which took place Monday night. The election and resultant consolidation, however, are still dependent on the approval of the Marion county court. Marion County Commissioner Roy Rice said Tuesday that the court would merely canvass the votes to determine if the election was carried out properly and that the consolidation was virtually assured.

Central water district, one of the four annexed areas, voted unanimously to come into the fold. As petitions, circulated among the other three districts, had carried all the property owners' signatures, they were not required to vote.
