KOAC to Start 26th Year as State Station

OREGON STATE COLLEGE, Dec. 4—A full Sunday schedule of programs has been arranged by Radio KOAC for Sunday, December 7, in celebration of the 25th anniversary of its founding on the OSC campus December 7, 1922. The program schedule will start at 10 o'clock in the forenoon and will continue to 10 o'clock at night. Ordinarily the station is silent on Sunday.

The entire day will be used to honor the founders and former staff members who pioneered in develop this station to one of the foremost today devoted exclusively to educational, non-commercial broadcasting. The physical plant, started and developed by the state college, is operated with a program service by the general extension division of the state system of higher education, affording an outlet for institutions of the system and other state departments.

Girl Accident Victim Sues

Suit for \$20,000 general and \$500 special damages for injuries allegedly suffered by Norma Jean Jones, Salem route 4, box 291, in a bicycle-auto accident August 30, was filed in Marion county circuit court Thursday.

Clyde J. Jones, father of the 14-year-old girl who was unconscious for 20 days following the accident, was appointed her guardian ad litem for the suit. Defendants named in the complaint are George James Mann and Mary L. Mann of Freeewater, Ore.

Mann was reported by state police to be the driver of the car which struck the girl, on her bicycle, while she was riding along highway 99E just south of the 12th street junction. The complaint alleges negligence on the part of defendants.
