Sharp Upturn

CHICAGO, Jan. 12 .- (AP)-Wheat led a sharp upturn in grains on the board of trade today following advices stating the government had reentered the flour market. The advance was helped by continued light marketings of cash grain and forecast of a cold wave in the winter wheat belt.

In wheat, March and July set new seasonal peaks. All corn deliveries made seasonal highs except the 1948 crop December contract, and the May delivery closed within % cent of the all-time high for any corn future made Sept. 15, 1847, at \$2.65%. Wheat closed 5 to 6% cents high-

er, May \$3.041/2-3.05, corn was 1/2 lower to 3% higher, May \$2.651/a-%, oats were unchanged to 11/4 higher, May \$1.251/4-1/6, and soybeans were unchanged to 5 cents higher, March \$4.30 to \$4.34.
