Bearishness Slows Market

NEW YORK, March 9-(AP)-General bearishness, together with erratic commodities, continued to depress the majority of today's stock market leaders.

An argument for the bulls, however, was that selling remained light throughout. Dealings turned sluggish after midday and extreme losses running to 2 or more points were reduced in most cases at the close. A smattering of pivotals managed to emerge with modest plus signs. Transfers for the five hours

dwindled to 660,000 shares. They compared with 740,000 Monday. Doubters regarding the domestic economic outlook and darkening international situations again trimmed accounts. Rising business failures to a peak since 1943 tended to chill sentiment. Skepticism anent taxes and wages still was a restraining influence.

The Associated Press 60-stock composite was off 4 of a point at 60.8, a bottom since February 27. Of 937 issues registering, 565 fell and 183 rose.


