TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is hereby given to all owners or persons claiming an interest in any land within the boundaries of the proposed Four Corners County Drainage District, to be organized and described in the hereinafter petition, that the petitioners, being owners of more than twenty percent of the acreage with in the boundaries of said proposed district, having filed their petition in the office of the County Clerk for the County of Marion, State of Oregon, at the hour of 10 o'clock A.M., in the County Court Room of the County Court House in Salem, Oregon, on the second day of March, 1948, and that said petition has been filed by the above petitioners for the hearing of the said District or to fixing of the line and place all persons interested in said petition and in the organization of said Four Corners County Drainage District, or in opposition thereto, or in any manner related to the organization of said District or to fixing of the boundaries thereof, may be heard.

That the following is a true and correct copy of said petition, to-wit:

"In the County Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Marion, in the Matter of the Organization of the Four Corners County Drainage District, TO THE HONORABLE COURT OF THE COUNTY OF MARION."

Come now, your petitioners, persons shown by the records of Marion County to be the owners of more than 20% of the acreage with in the boundaries of said proposed district, and who are interested in the effects of water for agricultural purposes, the same being conducive to the public health, welfare and safety of public utility and benefit, and for such purpose such owners have prepared and signed this petition in which they respectfully represent:

1. The name proposed for the District is Four Corners County Drainage District.
2. The boundary lines of said district are as follows: "Beginning at a point where the center line of Market Road No. 27 (known as East State Street) intersects the West line of lot 9 of City View as shown in Town Plat records for Marion County, Oregon; thence North along the West line of lots 9, 10 and 11 in said subdivision, to the South line of the Southern Pacific Company right-of-way, thence East along said right-of-way line to the East line of Elma Avenue, thence South along said East line of Elma Avenue to the South line of Beck Avenue, thence West along the South line of Beck Avenue to the West line of Market Road No. 27, (also known as Turner Road); thence North along the West line of said Turner Road to the South line of Maht Avenue, thence West along the South line of said Maht Avenue to the West line of Mable Street, thence North along the West line of said street and extension thereof to the Center line of Market Road No. 27 or East State Street, thence East along said Center line to the place of beginning."
3. The estimated acreage within said boundaries is 145 acres, and said land is wholly in Marion County, Oregon.
4. All or substantially all of the lands within said boundaries will be benefited.
5. The lands within the boundaries set forth constitute contiguous body of swamp, wet or overflowed land, waters from which contribute to the swamp, wet or overflowed condition of such lands and all of said lands will be benefited by the construction of drains, irrigation, flood or surface water control works.

WHEREFORE your petitioners pray that the lands included within the boundaries hereinabove described be organized as water control district under the provisions of Chapter 330, Oregon Laws 1946.
