Gov. Hall to Accept Plaque Honoring Mrs. Hendricks

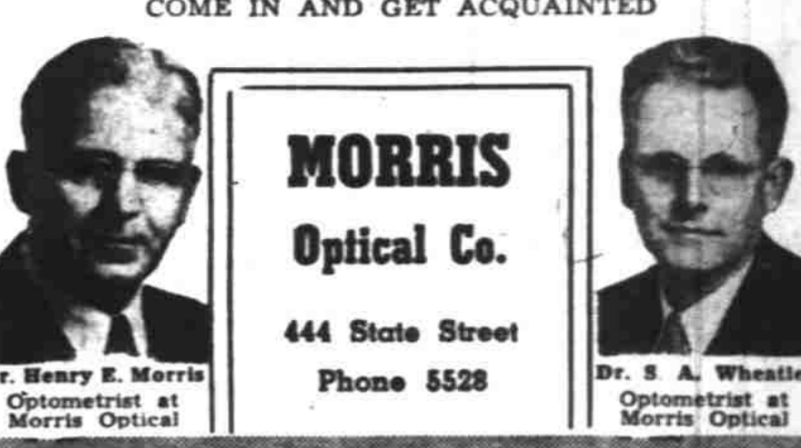
A plaque in memory of Mrs. Emilie G. Hendricks, Oregon's first war mother, is to be presented to the state for display in the capitol at a program Wednesday.
