Thief Takes \$438 In Series of Thefts At Labor Temple

City police are searching for a burglar who looted three union offices at the Salem Labor temple of \$438 early Thursday morning.

The looter then kicked a hole in the wall to enter the Culinary Workers union office where he stole \$124. Following the same procedure, the thief also entered offices of the Electrical Workers union where he took \$244 from several envelopes.

ing to within 13 miles of Weiser, Idaho, Weaver said. In addition to its flood control value, the proposed dam would house 10 generators with a capacity of 850,000 kilowatts and have provision for four more power units.

He said the project was not a "quicky" devised as a result of the current flood, but has been under survey and discussion for several years. Two public hearings on it were held last year. He said the cost estimate was based on 1947 prices.

The proposed dam would be 710 feet high and would back up the waters of the Snake in the mile-deep Hell's canyon to form a reservoir 89 miles long, extending to within 13 miles of Weiser, Idaho, Weaver said.
