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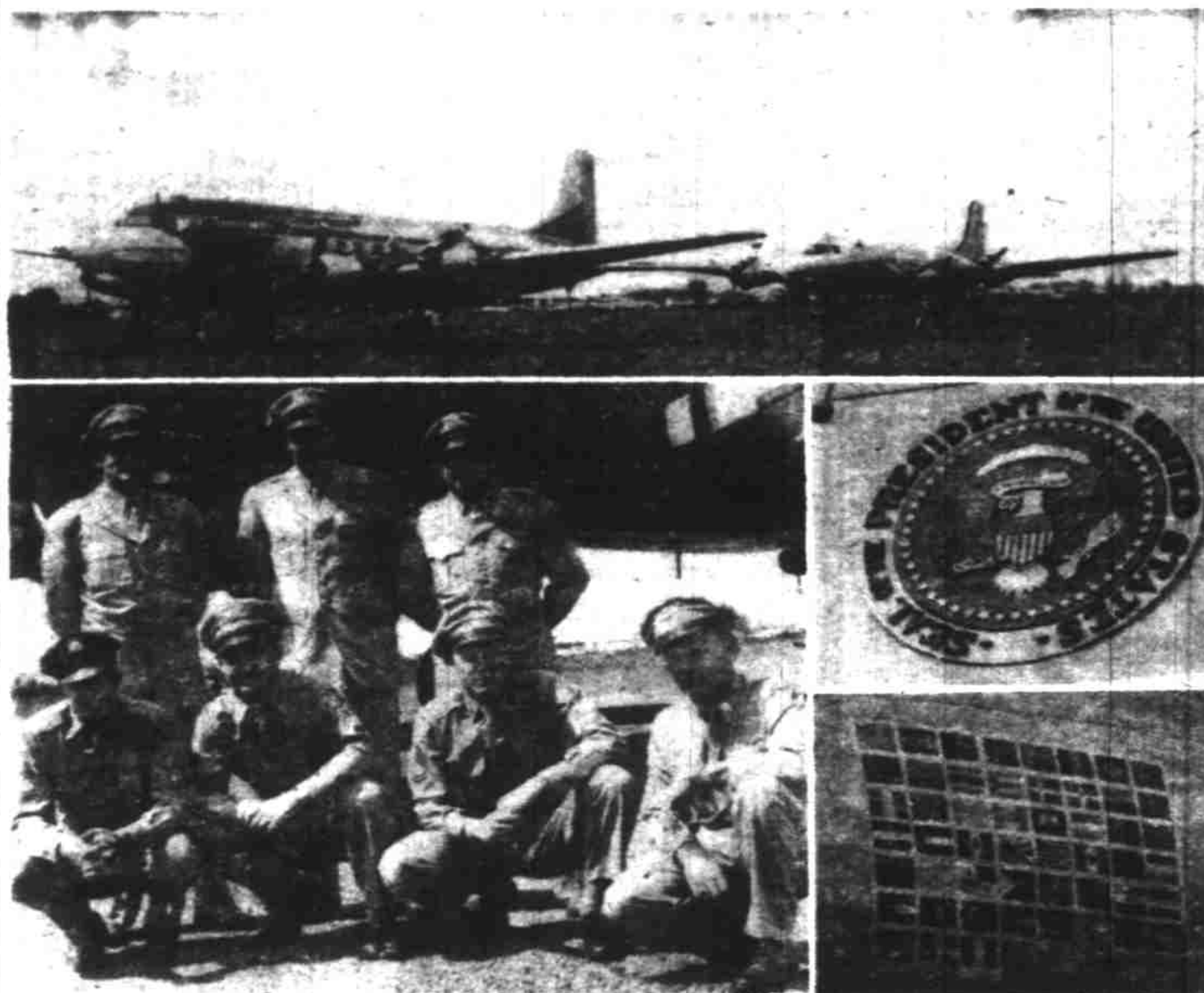
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Presidential Planes Visit Salem



At top are two airplanes, on the runway at Salem's McNary field Friday, that have become known to almost every American because of being presidential planes. At the left is President Harry S. Truman's "Independence", the latest in transport aircraft, and behind it the famous "Sacred Cow", the late President Franklin D. Roosevelt's personal plane. Truman's is a Douglas DC-6 and Roosevelt's is a Douglas DC-4, and both types are in common use on American airlines. The crew of the Independence is pictured at lower left, and are, left to right, (kneeling) M. Sgt. Fred J. Willard, Philadelphia, Pa., and M. Sgt. F. Winslow, Brewer, Maine, both flight engineers; T. Sgt. Robert Hughes, Hartford, Conn., flight steward; and M. Sgt. Charles Horton, Gravette, Ark., radio operator. Standing, left to right, Lt. Col. Francis Williams, Manhattan Beach, Calif., pilot; Maj. Elmer F. Smith, Clearwater, Calif., co-pilot; and Maj. T. J. Boselli, New York city, N.Y., navigator. All are the original flight crew of the Sacred Cow except Lt. Col. Williams. On the inside of the entry hatch of the Independence is the seal of the president of the U.S., shown in upper inset at the right. Below it are pictured the flags of 51 countries painted on the nose of the Sacred Cow, indicating the countries in which it has flown official missions. 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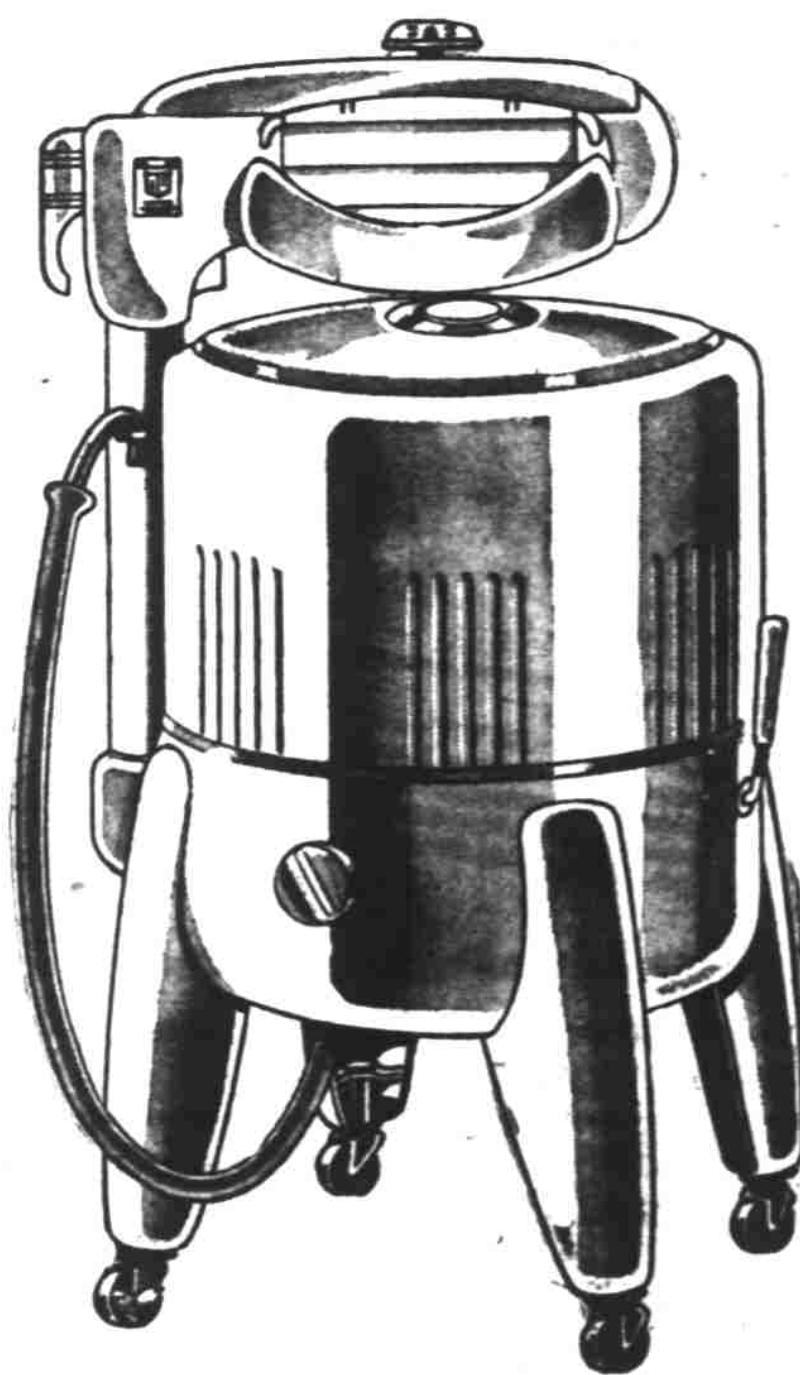
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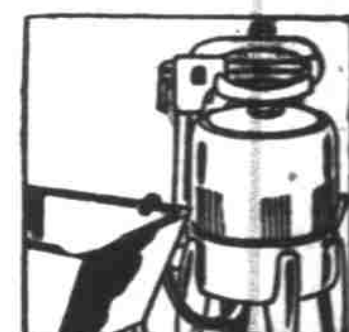
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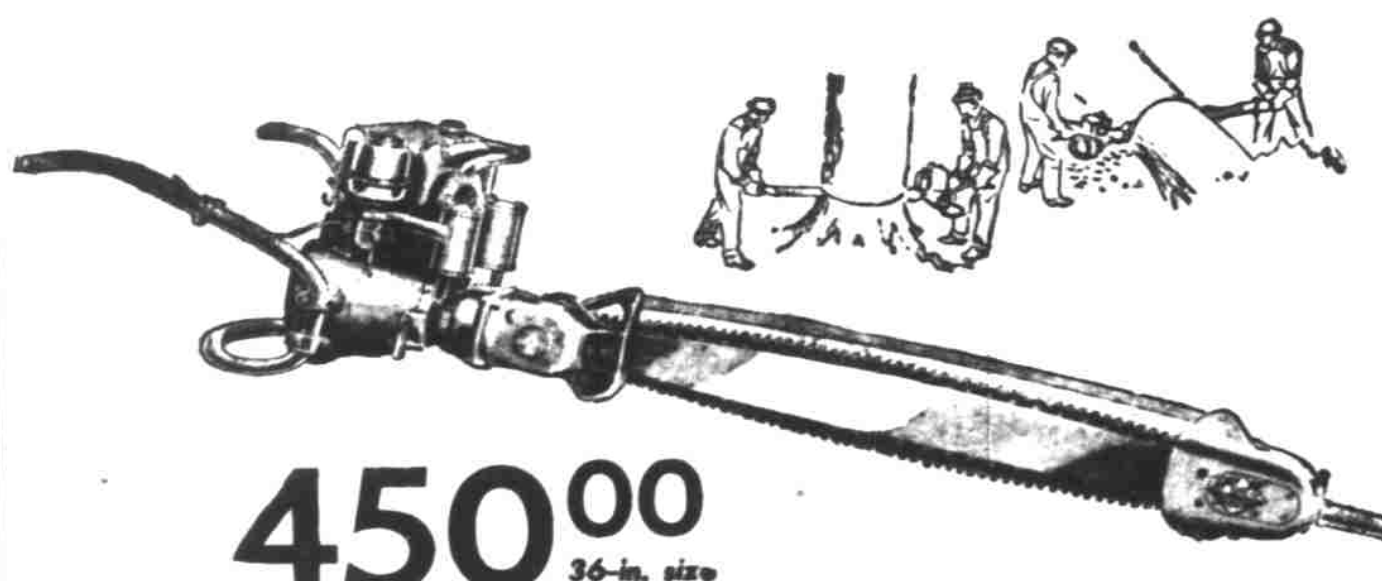
