

Revamping Set Soon for New **Bus Terminal** 

Remodeling of a building on the northeast corner of High and Marion streets will begin soon, it was stated Monday by Ralph Borrego, property owner who will recondition the present one-story, 70 by 40 foot building as a Trailways bus depot and add a second story with six general office spaces

Borrego said the go-ahead on actual work awaits only inspection of the site by Eugene Allen, Trailways' general manager of San Francisco, who is expected here next week.

The bus depot will include news stand and restaurant concessions, the latter to be operated by Floyd McNall. Borrego estimated the entire

emodeling cost at \$10,000. He said the project, which he will supervise himself, would be completed in about six weeks. Trailways is now using the present building, a former grocery.
