Corn Prices Continue Sag

CHICAGO, Aug. 10-(P)-Liquidation in the corn pit influenced price action at the board of trade today. Corn was easy at the opening and continued to sag, as traders prepared for an optimistic government estimate of the condition of crops set of August 1.

Selling in the corn pit was reflected in wheat, for a time, but toward the close a good rally carried some deliveries to around 2 cents higher than the previous close.

Corn advanced from the day's low toward the finish and at the close, wheat was 2 1/2 higher to 2 cents lower, September \$2.31 1/4-6. Corn was 2 cents lower, September \$1.60-1.59. Oats were 2 1/2 to 3 cents lower, September 72-72 1/2. Rye was 1 1/2 to 2 cents lower, December \$1.67 1/2 and soybeans were 2 cents lower to 1 cent higher, December \$2.63 1/4.
