Few Contests, Many Vacancies On Precinct Committee Ballot

Republicans in 66 of Marion county's 92 precincts may vote for precinct committeemen or committeewomen in the November 2 elections while only 13 precincts will have democratic contenders.

Filing of precinct committee candidates closed last month. Vacancies not filled at the polls will be plugged by each party's county central committee, according to County Clerk Harlan Judd.

Seventy five republicans seek precinct committeeman posts, as compared with 15 democrats. Eight precincts will see a congested election in the GOP men's camp and two in the democrat.

Thirty-seven republicans are out for precinct committeewoman positions against 12 democrats. A contested election will occur in only one precinct among the lady democrats and none in republican districts.

Republican committeeman elections will occur in 31 precincts outside Salem and in 25 in the city limits (only precinct 26 is missing). Male democrats are up for balloting in 4 precincts outside the city and 4 inside Salem.

Lady republicans are out for votes in 18 precincts outside Salem and in 19 precincts within the city. Only two precincts in the county and nine in the city will have democratic committeewomen running.

Both Sexes, Women
 In only 32 precincts will republicans see both men and women candidates out for committee offices. Four precincts will have democrats of both sexes facing the voters.

In the republican camp precincts which will have committeeman contests include Auburn, H. C. Sealfield and Orville F. Ward; Englewood, Kenneth O. Runner and Theodore R. Stook; Salem 1, Lawrence J. Kelsh, L. R. M. Pierce and Val Dare Sloper; Salem 7, F. F. Bodmer and John W. Sides; Salem 19, Chris J. Kowitz and J. A. Shinn; Salem 25, Frederick C. Klaus and Robert McEwan; Salem 33, Frederick S. Lampert and Richard G. Severin; Salem 34, Arthur A. Fisher and Lewis Judson.

Democrat men candidates will vie in Salem 10 where Edward E. Gideon and Myrton Moore are on the ballot and in Salem 25 with John A. Rademaker and Terry L. Randall contesting. In Salem 30 Jessie Day and Mary E. Eyre will contest for the committeewoman post.
