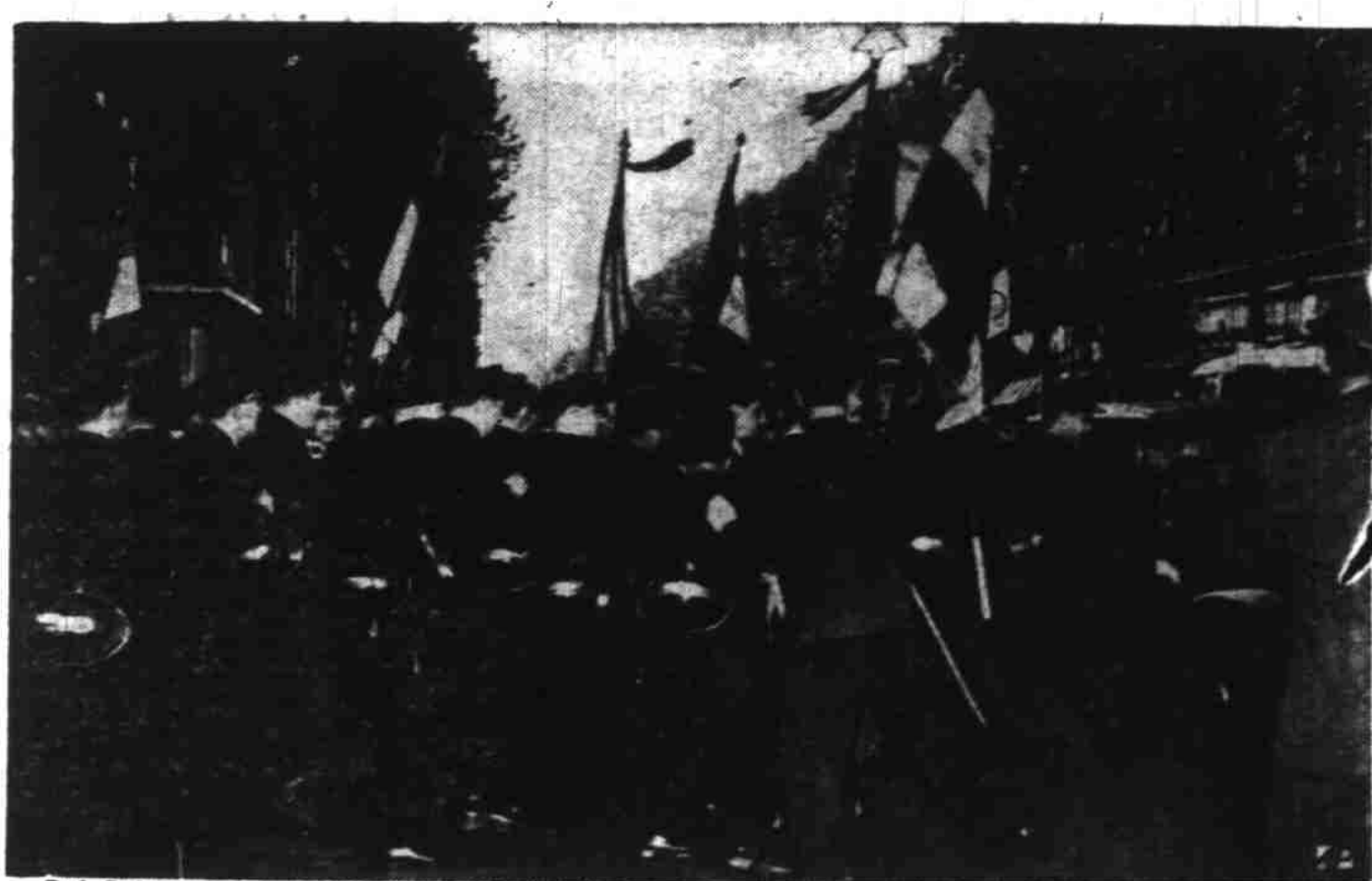

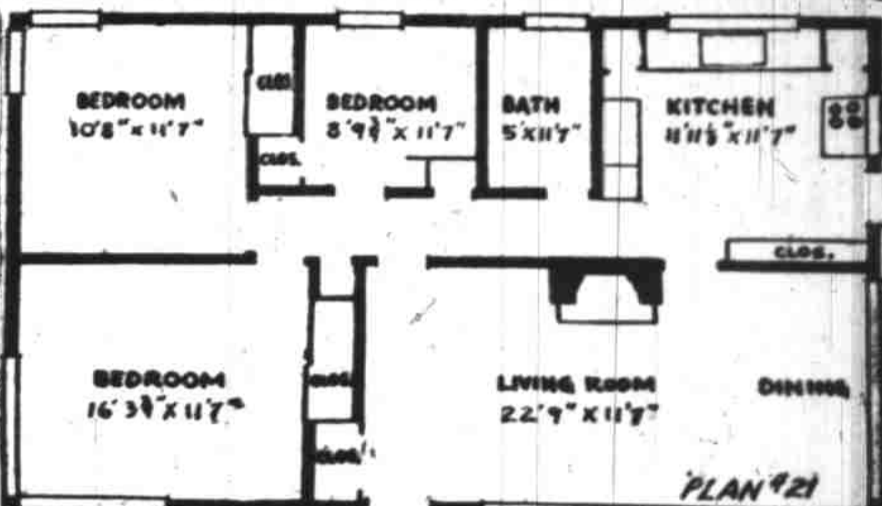
## State Senate Vote Reduces GOP Margin

 Democrats picked up four seats in the Oregon state senate, it appeared today. The 1948 prospects were for 21 republicans and 9 democrats, compared with a 25 to 5 count last session.
