T. C. asks when to prune holly. Says her bush is out of shape. Wants to know if heavy branches can be cut off. Ans.: This is the time to prune

the holly, when cutting the berries. Care should be taken at all times, in cutting berries, to keep the bush in shape. It yields better and longer and makes a much nicer looking shrub. Larger branches can be sawed off but it should be done expertly and you will naturally lose some holly for a year or two. Paint the larger cuts with a disinfectant. Always, when pruning berried shrubs, cutting greenery or just


