

### Bishop Talks To Methodists

Emphasizing that quantity means nothing without quality, Bishop Gerald Kennedy outlined the opportunities and the needs of the coming four-year program at the Salem district Methodist conference here Thursday evening.

The new bishop of the Portland area declared the church must follow the example of its founder, John Wesley, and go to the people rather than wait for them to come.

And then, he added, it must "provide warm fellowship inside."
