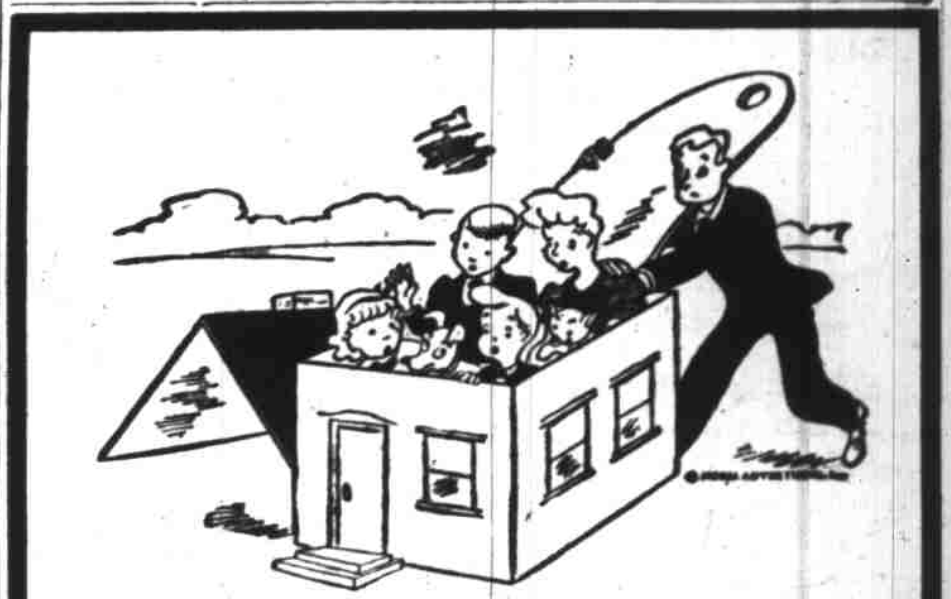
Paulina Road Contract Let

The state highway commission Thursday awarded a contract for 4.63 miles of roadbed widening and 15.83 miles of rock or gravel surfacing on the Paulina-Eagle Rock creek section of the Paulina secondary highway in Crook county to T. W. Thomas, Portland, on a low bid of \$54,000.

Crook county will contribute \$35,000 of the cost of the project. There were 18 bidders.
