Gehrmann Cops Mile Classic; Dwyer Ties Mark

NEW YORK, Jan. 29 (AP)—Little Don Gehrmann of Wisconsin captured the Wanamaker mile at the Millrose indoor games to-night, coming from behind with a terrific burst of speed to pass Willy Slykhuus of Holland less than ten yards from the tape. A sellout crowd of more than 15,000 gave the national collegiate champion a tremendous ovation as he came pounding up on the outside to snatch the victory in his final strides in the smart time of 4:09.5 and keep the Wanamaker classic from having its first foreign winner. John Twomey of the Illinois Athletic club finished third, less

than ten yards behind Slykhuus, while Ingvar Bengtsson of Sweden, victorious in his two previous American 1,000-yard races, wound up poor last in the field of six. Gaston Reiff of Belgium, the Olympic 5,000 meter champion, made his American debut by winning the two-mile run in 8:56.1, fastest time recorded on the boards since Greg Rice, the world indoor record holder, retired half a dozen years ago. The Belgian stepper also exhibited brilliant finish and was going away when he broke the tape a good six yards in front of the Swedish Olympian, Erik Ahlden.

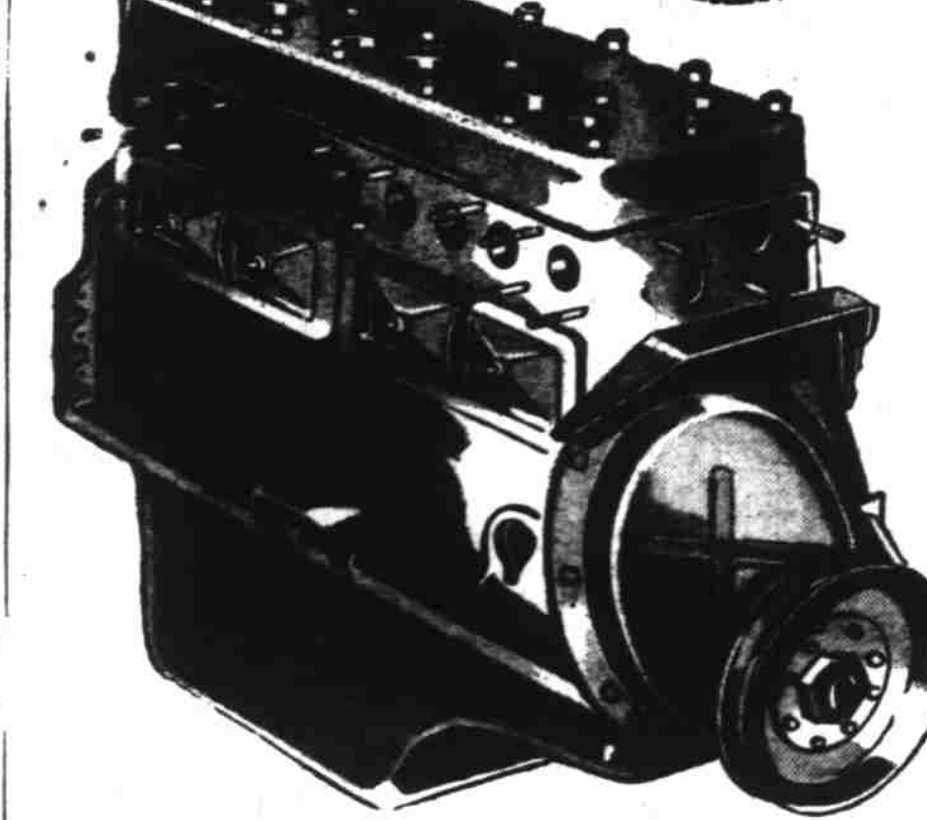
