

Here's a Pretty Cake and Very Tasty, Too



TOW MANY TIMES have you feasted your eyes on a beautiful cake or salad and said, "Goodmess, that's just too pretty to eat"? Well, here's another tempting one to add to the list-a luscious Pumpkin Cake. And we'll wager, pretty as it is, you will be more satisfied with a generous portion-or two, or three. Here is the recipe:


Pumpkin Cake Dessert

% cup 4 teaspoons baking powder 1 cup brown sugar 1/4 tenspoon salt % cup white sugar

1/2 teaspoon nutmeg 14 teaspoon cinnar K cup strained 1/4 teaspoon ginger cooked pumpkin % cup chopped 1 cup heavy cream,

2% cups sifted flour oon soda whipped Whole English walnut halves

Cream margarine and sugars together until light. Beat eggs and stir in pumpkin and sour milk. Sift flour with soda, baking newder, salt and spices. Add flour and pumpkin mixtures alternately to creamed margarine beating after each addition. Pour into a greased and wax paper lined 9-inch square baking pan. Bake in a moderately hot oven (375 degrees F.) 49-50 minutes. Remove from pan and cool on rack. When cool, spread with sweetened whipped cream and dot with walnut kernels. Yield: one 9-inch cake.


