Persistent Hoarseness

culosis, syphilis or swelling of the possible. aorta, the large artery coming from the heart. For this reason, it never pays to neglect hoarseness. Whenever it lasts for more than two weeks, it demands a careful study to learn its cause.

Generally speaking, hoarseness factors eliminated, such as abuse usually comes as a result of voice of tobacco, alcohol, or working strain, inflammation, or infectious in surroundings where there is a conditions.

In carrying out the examination

to determine the cause of the hoarseness, the patient's history must be scrutinized and his habits, such as the use of tobacco and alcohol, taken into consideration. His occupation may be a factor, particularly if he works in a dusty or smoky place or comes in contact with industrial gases. Physical Examination

The pattient should have a complete physical examination, studies of the blood, and x-rays of the chest and nasal sinuses. The laryngoscope, an instrument made up of a tube with aa light, should be used so that the doctor can look directly into the larynx. If
