Stephens' Homer Wins for Bosox Giants Blanked but Hold Lead;

The Washington Senators proved Thursday they weren't immune to getting beat in the American league, and went down, 2-1, to the Detroit Tigers at Detroit to end a winning streak that had reached nine in a row. Virgil (Fire) Trucks, who has been the ace of the Tigers mound brigade this season, hurled a five-hitter for his fifth win.

Although they were rained out of their game with the Cardinals, the Boston Braves wound up in a tie with the Giants for first place. Hank Borowy for the Phillies downed his former Chicago Cubs mates, 4-3, and Ralph Branca, although belted hard all the way went the route to beat Pittsburgh 11-6 for Brooklyn in the other National league skirmishes.

Lesnevich Mgr. Protests Fine

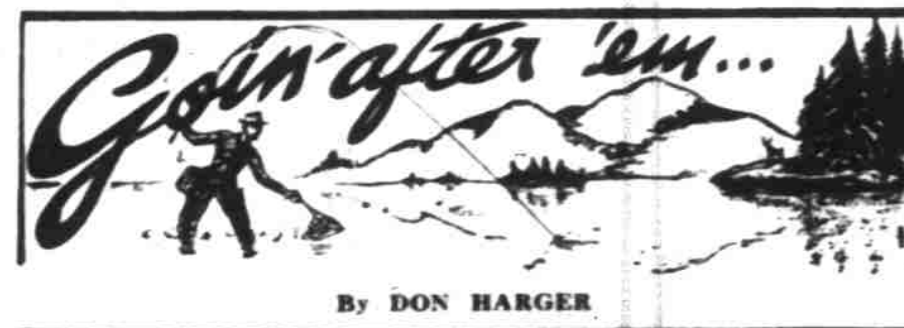
