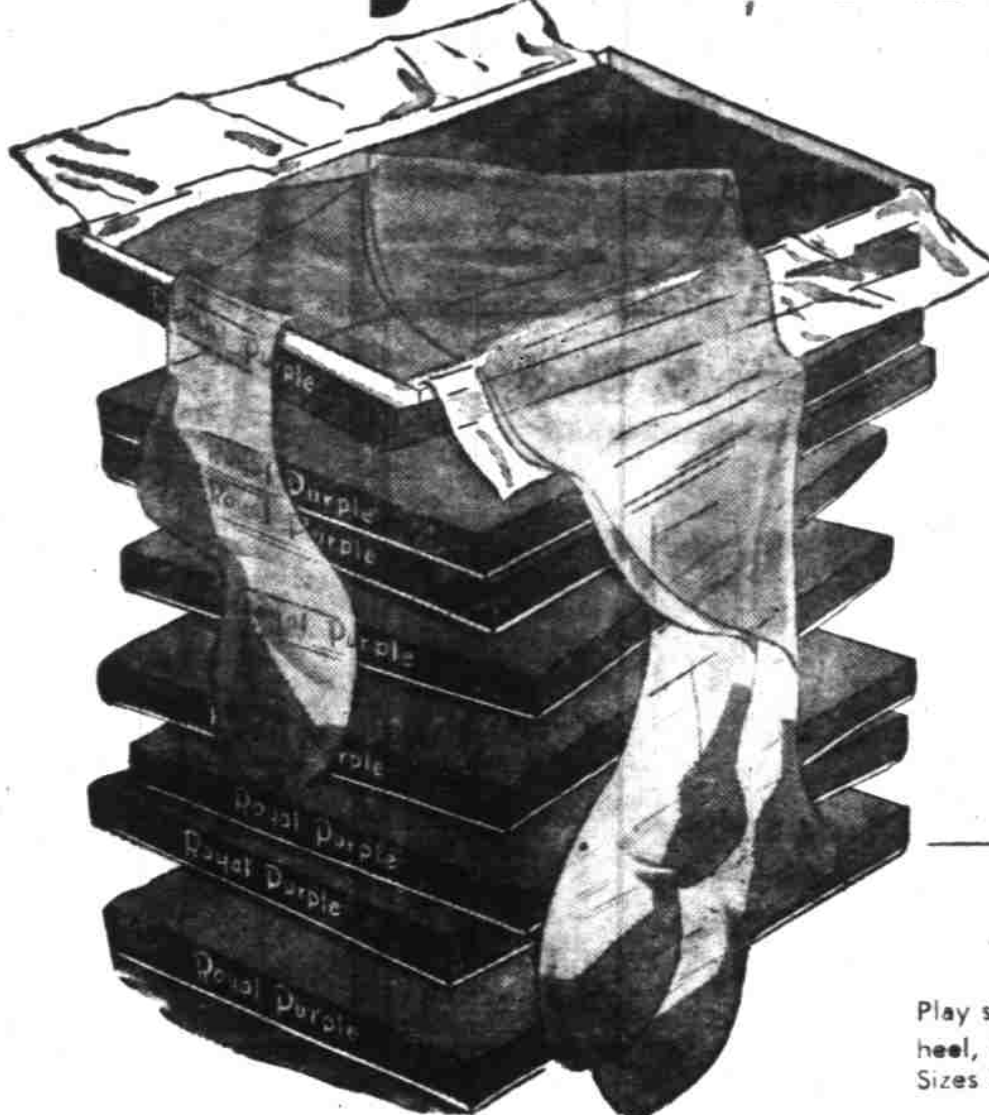
Phyllis Freres Honor Guest
